# Health

## I. Chisapani Hospital Upgradation Project

The Chaudhary Foundation is committed to strengthening and improving healthcare services at Chisapani Hospital from multiple angles, which include enhancing infrastructure, providing essential medical equipment, and bolstering the hospital's human resources. We have expanded our assistance by equipping the hospital with vital medical devices, implementing practical systems like the Token system, and introducing effective waste management solutions. Additionally, we have undertaken renovations in various departments such as OPD, Intra Patient Department (IPD), store, Anti Natal Checkup (ANC)/Post Natal Checkup (PNC) area, patient waiting area, LAB, and XRAY room, along with the installation of hand washing stations and medical equipment. Furthermore, we have organized training programs to improve the soft skills of the hospital staff in various domains. An extensive Organizational and Management Survey has been carried out to evaluate the hospital's overall operational status and identify potential areas for enhancement. Moreover, we have recently inaugurated the Sabal Center, which serves as the sole facility for fitting artificial limbs in Nawalparasi.



### • Soft Skill Training at Chisapani Hospital

Chaudhary Foundation organized coaching and mentoring sessions for the nursing staff of Chisapani Hospital on patient safety goals and basic life support soft skills, as well as the safe use of hospital equipment. We believe, this coaching will be highly advantageous for the nursing team, as it equips them with the necessary skills and



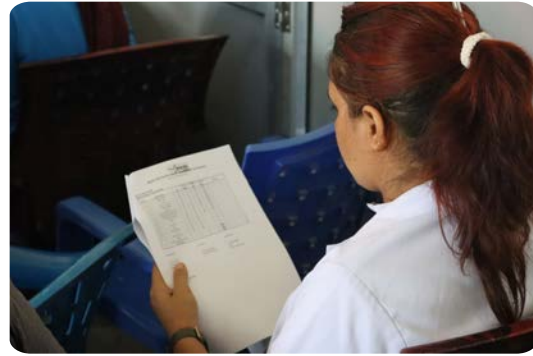
knowledge to handle their daily responsibilities with exceptional attention and care for patients.



## • Orientation on Hospital Waste Management

Chaudhary Foundation conducted a two-day orientation program on the 25th and 26th of September to enhance the soft skills of the Chispani Hospital team in implementing hospital waste management system. The main focus of this initiative is to establish a highly effective hospital waste management system that prioritizes safety, environmental responsibility, and compliance with regulations.





## • Digital Token System

Chaudhary Foundation has installed a Digital Token System in Chisapani Hospital for queue management. This innovative solution will help to streamline and enhance the overall patient experience, reducing wait times and ensuring efficient access to healthcare services. With this technology in place, patients can expect a more organized and dignified queuing process, ultimately improving the hospital's capacity to deliver prompt and effective care to those in need.



## • Sabal Center in Chisapani Hospital

With the support of the Chaudhary Foundation, the CG Sabal Center project has started at Chisapani Hospital in Bardghat-2. Through this Sabal Center, people without limbs can get artificial limbs fitted for free. CG Sabal Center is also



operational in Madhyabindu District Hospital of Nawalpur. About one thousand people have benefited from the same center so far.



## II. Breastfeeding Week Celebration

The Chaudhary Foundation marked Breastfeeding Week from August 1st to August 7th at the Paklihawa Birthing Center under the theme "Let's make breastfeeding and work, work!." This awareness campaign aimed to emphasize the significance of breastfeeding for the health and welfare of both mothers and infants.

This celebration went beyond being solely an educational event; it also served as a community gathering to acknowledge the vital role that breastfeeding plays in fostering the well-being of both infants and mothers.



## III. Baliyo Mahila Training

Chaudhary' Foundation organized Baliyo Mahila program-a groundbreaking initiative aimed at enhancing the capabilities of women entrepreneurs in the production, marketing, and distribution of iron-rich food products. Altogether 32 women from 4 Palikas of Parasi district were part of the program from 25th September to 29th September 2023 at Bardaghat.

This program seeks to establish a circular dynamic between demand and supply, with Baliyo Mahilas (women entrepreneurs) serving as providers of Baliyo Fortified Foods (BFFs) while simultaneously educating and encouraging consumers, including girls, women of reproductive age (WRA), and pregnant and lactating women (PLW), about the health benefits of incorporating BFFs into their diets.







## IV. Blood Donation & Free Health Checkup

## *Activities of Nawalparasi Project*

### I. Polytechnic Certificate Distribution

We conducted a certificate distribution ceremony for 84 graduates who successfully completed our 6-month Polytechnic program.



## II. Interaction Program with Arun Kapur

Chaudhary Foundation organized an interaction program with the academia and government stakeholders of Parasi district on the present education system of Nepal. We had a guest Mr Arun kapur-an educator with more than four decades of experience in the global spheres of public and private education.



## III. Cart Wheel Distribution

Chaudhary Foundation granted ten households a 'Thela' (cartwheel) and an initial sum of Rs. 5000 as seed capital. This initiative allows these households to start their own small businesses tailored to their unique needs and income streams, thereby enabling them to establish a reliable source of income.





#### IV. Training of Trainers (TOT) on Electrical Appliances, Service and Repair

Chaudhary Foundation has successfully completed Training of Trainers (TOT) on Electrical Appliance Service and Repair with a special focus on Refrigerators, AC, and Washing Machine. The session was facilitated by Mr. Robin Thomas - trainer from LG India, who took the lead in demonstrating the troubleshooting techniques and providing hands-on demonstrations for Refrigerator, Air Conditioner, and Washing Machine repair. 20 participants including electrical and mechanical engineers, technical experts, and technicians were part of the program. We would like to thank everyone for their valuable time throughout the training.





## ***Activities of UNNATI***

### **I. Entrepreneur Expo & Summit in Chitwan**



The Entrepreneur Expo & Summit in Chitwan, organised by the Women Entrepreneurs Forum of Chitwan Association of Industries and Women Creation Center, took place from September 8-10, 2023. The UNNATI team participated for three days, showcasing pottery, ceramic, and natural fibres products from the Unnati Cultural Village—the event aimed to promote UNNATI products to consumers in Chitwan and neighbouring regions. Participants included provincial government bodies, chambers of commerce, government officials, and the Armed Police Force. The team promoted the products through booth visits, postcard distribution, and contact information exchange.



## II. The Teej & Jitiya festival

**The Teej & Jitiya festival**, celebrated by women, aims to empower women by promoting local artisans, businesses, and traditional crafts. The event occurred on September 14, 15, and 16, 2023, at UNNATI Cultural Village (UCV) in Harkapur, Gaidakot Municipality, Nawalpur. The festival featured various stalls showcasing locally crafted, traditional, and handmade items, as well as activities like Teej storytelling, Lakhe Dance performances, lucky draws for Maulakalika cable car tickets and Jitiya Parba. The 3 day event met its success by welcoming a diverse participants of over 300 audience and families, adding a vibrant and inclusive atmosphere to the celebrations by providing a platform for exhibiting and marketing their products .
